## **Physical Punishment Statement**

CenClear **does not permit** any form of physical punishment as a form of disciplining children. Examples of physical punishment, punishment touches, include but are not limited to:

Hitting

	●Biting	●Bending fingers or wrist	
	●Slapping	●Twisting arms, legs or feet	
	Yanking arms	<ul><li>Dragging</li></ul>	
	●Pulling hair or ears	<ul><li>Poking</li></ul>	
	●Shaking	<ul><li>Scratching</li></ul>	
	<ul> <li>Squeezing body parts, face, arms, shoulders, neck, etc.</li> </ul>	●Punching	
	•Smacking hand or fingers		
Additionally, CenClear volunteers <b>may not</b> participate in aversive punishment or therapy. Examples of this would include but are not limited to:			
•Putting noxious substances (such as soap, pepper, vinegar, hot sauce) on lips, tongue or any other body part of child.			
●Making child smell noxious materials.			
●Forcing child to eat non-foods or noxious substances.			
Applying electric shocks to a child.			
Violation of this policy will result in immediate suspension from the classroom as a volunteer. Mandated reports to Children, Youth, & Family Services will be made, if needed.
