Driver Services

All Driver License Centers and Photo License Centers in Pennsylvania will be closed. Driver and vehicle online services are still available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at. These services include driver's license, photo ID and vehicle registration renewals; driver-history services; changes of address; driver license and vehicle registration restoration letters; ability to pay driver license or vehicle insurance restoration fee; driver license and photo ID duplicates; and driver exam scheduling. There are no additional fees for using online services. Expiration dates for driver licenses, identification cards, vehicle

registrations, and safety and emission inspections scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020 through March 31, 2020 will be extended until April 30, 2020.
