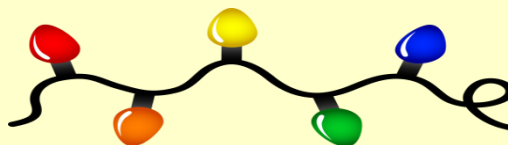
- This month we will begin our study on Clothes!

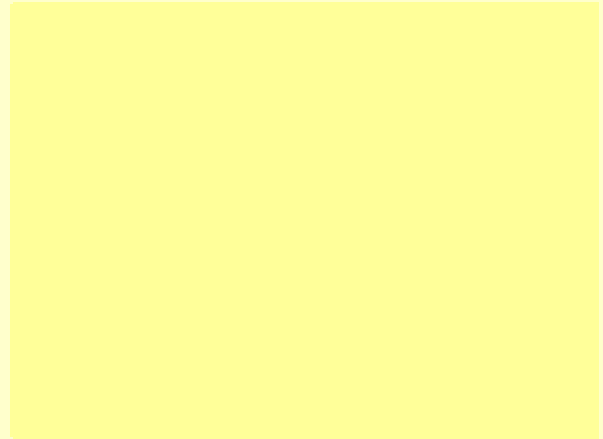
- We will continue our Roads study this month. The children will create a map to their house. We will also learn about types of roads, how we make roads and how they help us every day.
