*January Socialization for Tami and Megan:

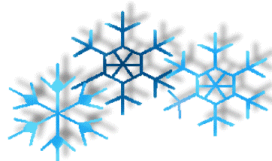
- January 22, 2019 at 4:30-6:30 pm. The theme is winter.
