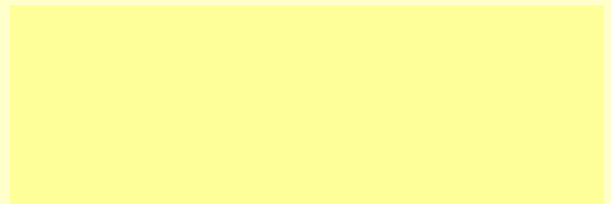
## Reminders to Parents
