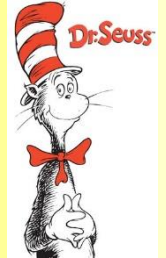

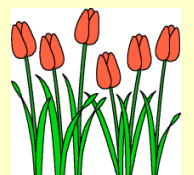
- We will be having Virtual Socialization on March 10th and 24th. We will be starting at 11:30 AM.
