- Volunteer hours and the reading challenge are due back to Miss Stephanie at the end of every month.

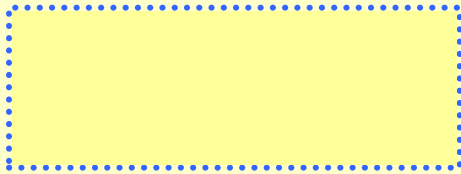
Ms. Brandi

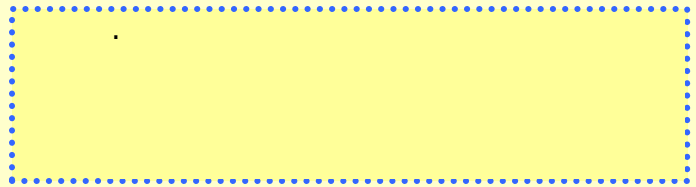
Reminders to Parents
