- **First Day Hike at Parker Dam State Park-** Tuesday, January 1, 2019 at 11:00am to 12:30pm

Hike will traverse the CCC Trail through the northern section of the park to the location of the former CCC Camp, S-73, which is the Organized Group Tenting Area. There is no cost and the park may provide a limited number of snowshoes if there is significant snow (10+ inches) depth. Meet at parking area near CCC Museum/Spillway.

- **Clearfield YMCA's Annual Winter Fest at Parker Dam State Park-** Saturday, January 26, 2019 at 9:00am to 4:00pm

Saturday includes the 5K Run, Blizzard Volleyball, Ice Fishing Basics, Learn to Skate, and Snowshoeing.

Miss Stephanie

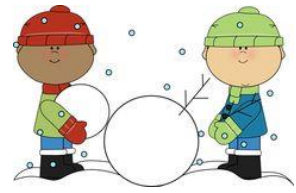
- We will be starting the Tree Study.

- Also remember to send in hats and mittens because we go outside to play as long as the weather is above 25 degrees.



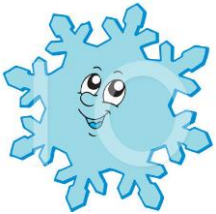
Miss Mary
