

- Please remember that we are aiming to get a lot of fresh air during this winter season. Please feel free to send in boots, hats, and gloves. As we start to bring in our bulky winter items, the cubbies in our room will get crowded. Everything usually fits; it just takes a little patience and skill. Work with your child to find the loop on the inside neck of their coat. Work on (the fine motor) skill of hanging their coat, using this loop. Talk with your child about pushing all of their items into their cubby- to ensure that they are not touching anyone else's things. If you have a Kindergarten child, now is the time to start talking with them about how important it is to make sure your coat, and belongings do not touch other people's items. When your items touch other people's items, you can get/give lice and germs. It is important to take care of our things- this helps to keep us healthy and safe.
