- Hope everyone has a safe and happy holiday!

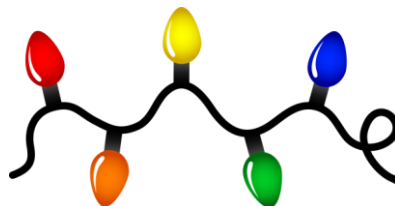

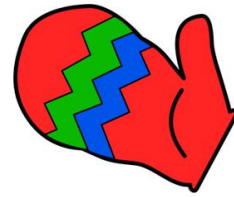
