## This Month's Highlights

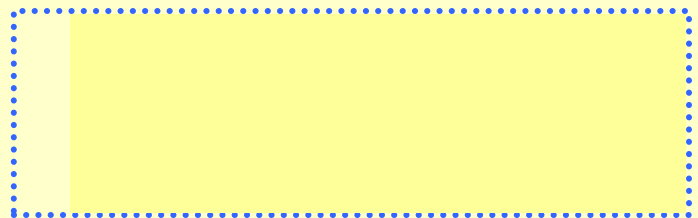
- Face masks are to be worn all day in accordance to government health and safety guidelines. Questions about any or this can be addressed with your child's teacher.
