Upcoming Events:

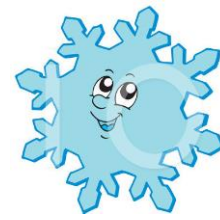
- **No Policy Council Meeting this month.**

Pre-K Counts News

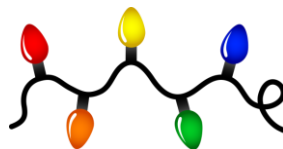
Miss Aubrie
