- CenClear is always accepting applications- please spread the word!

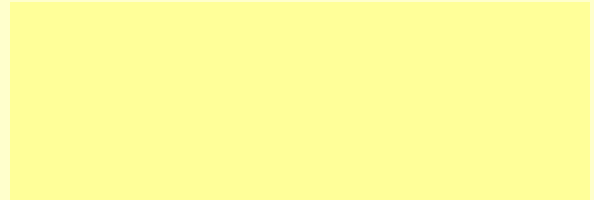
