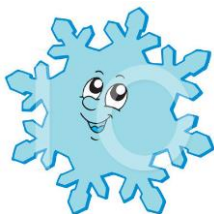
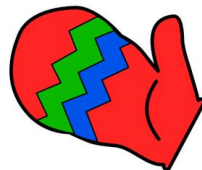
(Miss Jodie)
