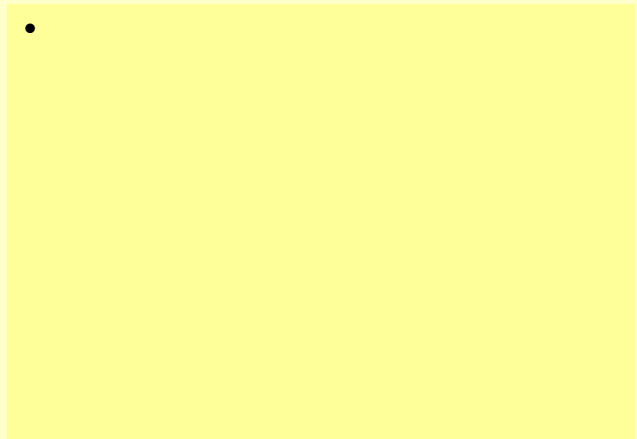
Virtual Family Connections

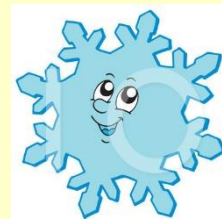


Reminders to Parents
