 - Wednesday's at 10:30 am for Preschool (Ages 3-6)

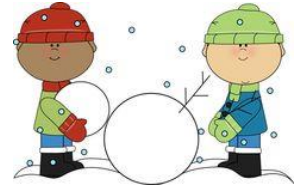
Head Start News

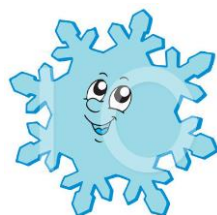
- January's theme is going to be clothes.

- Please try to have your child here by the time school starts at 8:15 am.

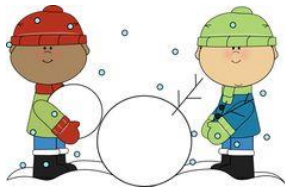
